Our employees must be capable of recognizing the individual needs of each child, working with them in a positive and constructive manner, maintaining records on the skill development of each child, and providing a fun experience. Employees must also be responsive to feedback and ready to grow.

About Us: TYC and GHYC Junior Sail partner together to run sail camp programming and the Narrows Race Team. Employees represent both programs and may be asked to work at either our TYC Wollochet Bay Outstation facility (3418 White Cloud Ave NW, Gig Harbor, WA 98335) or our facility at West Shore Marina (3815 Harborview Dr, Gig Harbor, WA 98332).

Positions and Requirements:

Narrows Race Team Summer Coach: (Multiple positions available, 20 to 40 hours per week depending upon applicant availability and program needs)

- Must be age 18 at the start of employment
- Must hold the following certifications by the start of employment:
 - U S Sailing Level 1 Certification (Level 2 or 3 preferred), CPR, First Aid, Heads Up CDC Concussion Training, SafeSport, and WA Boater Education.
- Wages will range from \$15 – \$18 per hour depending upon experience and assignment.
- Work schedule: evening practices M/W/F or T/TH from 4:00-8:00 & weekend regattas (averaging 20 hours/weekend). Positions are flexible based on applicant availability. Summer Season is June 7th - Sept 3
- Must demonstrate good judgment, and be capable of supervising young children in a safe environment.
- Responsibilities: plan and manage practice sessions; work as a team to demonstrate skills; drive the chase boat; conduct instructional classes; organize materials; set up and take down boats; plan and conduct non-sailing activities; follow and adapt lesson plans as needed; be a positive role model.

Lead Instructor: (Multiple positions available, 20 to 40 hours per week depending upon enrollment)

- Must be age 16 at the start of employment
- Must hold the following certifications by the start of employment:
 - U S Sailing Level 1 Certification, CPR, First Aid, Heads Up CDC Concussion Training, SafeSport, and WA Boater Education.
- Wages will range from \$15 – \$17 per hour depending upon experience and assignment
- Work schedule: Monday through Friday, June 14 - September 3, from 8:30 am - 4:30 pm (1/2 hour lunch off).
- Must demonstrate good judgment, and be capable of supervising young children in a safe environment.

- Responsibilities: mentor younger members of staff; lead classes and monitor progress of participants; work as a team to demonstrate skills; drive the chase boat; conduct instructional classes; organize materials; set up and take down boats; plan and conduct non-sailing activities; follow and adapt lesson plans as needed; be a positive role model.
